(RESIDENTS' AND CONTROLLED PARKING) (ZONE 15) ORDER 200-

NOTICE is hereby given that the Bath and North East Somerset Council proposes to make an order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which will create residents' and controlled parking Zone 16 . The restrictions will be residents' parking places, no waiting at any time, and 2 hour limited waiting. The affected roads are **Alpine Gardens (Even Numbers 18 to 50), Belgrave Crescent, Bennett's Lane, Camden Crescent, Camden Road, Camden Row, Camden Terrace, Footpath number BC55/3, Frankly Buildings, Gay's Hill, Lansdown Grove, Lower Hedgemoad Road, Margaret's Hill, Seymour Road, St Stephen's Road, Upper Hedgemoad Road, Bath.**

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order, which together with a map and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the order may be inspected at Trimbridge House, Trim Street, Bath and at our offices below during normal office hours.
